SUMMARY: There has been some Broom Reversing Valve (9030440) failures on Regulators and Snow Fighters. After investigation, we found there is a possible machining error in valve body which creates a burr and could potentially cause failure to valve o-ring.

OPERATIONAL IMPACT: Once the valve fails, the broom will become inoperable.

ACTION: When the valve fails, please call Knox Kershaw Service Department, with your machine serial number, and we'll have a replacement sent out. Please return the failed valve back to Knox Kershaw Inc.
